Dinghy Sailing

An approved Royal Yachting Association (RYA) Training Centre, WBB teaches sailing from basic beginner skills (RYA Level 1 & 2) to advanced techniques (spinnaker handling, etc).

ADULT (24yrs +) RYA LEVEL 1 & 2 FOUR DAY COURSES:

£280 including 2 free after-course session vouchers or £20 discount on season ticket.



Kayaking & Canoeing

WBB is a British Canoe Union (BCU) Approved Centre providing training from the most basic skills (BCU 1 and 2 Stars) through to advanced techniques including whitewater, slalom, sprint, freestyle and instructor training. See overleaf for session schedule.

Powerboating

RYA Level 1 & 2: This two-day course provides the skills and background knowledge needed to drive a powerboat and is the basis of the International Certificate of Competence. It includes close-quarters handling, high speed manoeuvres, man overboard recovery & collision regulations. £300 for a 2 day course.

Pimlico Paddlers & Westminster Windjammers

These are independent clubs, available to annual season ticket holders, which organise adult away-trips for sailing and kayaking.

SCHOOLS & YOUTH GROUPS:

WBB provides sessions either during school hours or as extra-curricular after-school sessions in both kayaking and sailing. Please contact us for more details.
